Special Clause for Returned Exhibition

and Demonstration Goods

Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, this insurance (War & S.R.C.C. risks are subject to their respective Institute Clauses or similar Clauses) remains in force during the period of the exhibition, demonstration, display and return voyage, and terminates either,

- i) on delivery to the warehouse or place of storage at the place named in the Policy, or
- ii) on the expiry of 90 days from the commencement of transit at the warehouse or place of storage at the place named in the policy,

whichever shall first occur.

In no case, however, shall the Insurer be liable to exceed the amount listed in the policy (or equivalent to in other currencies) per any one accident under this Clause.

In addition, it is specially understood and agreed that this insurance shall extend to cover the risk of mechanical and electrical derangement of the insured interest occurring during exhibition, demonstration and display.

Nothing in this Clause shall be deemed to extend to cover loss of or damage to the insured interest caused by faulty design, material defective, inherent vice or nature of the insured interest and gross negligent work of the Insured.
