SPECIAL CLAUSE FOR INSPECTION AND FORWARDING CHARGES (B)

Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, it is specially understood and agreed that if it become necessary for the Insured to inspect the degree of loss of or damage to the insured interest caused by a peril insured against, shall the Insurer pay any inspection and/or survey fees and charges and also pay the reasonable following costs and/or charges for the purpose of recovering, saving or preserving the insured interest, whether physical loss of or damage to the insured interest has arisen or not,

i) costs for sending supervisors or engineers, or

ii) forwarding charges to the Insured's factory or other places and/or afterwards to the original destination named in the policy for reshipment

In no case, however, shall the Insurer be liable to exceed the amount listed in the policy.

In addition, it is also understood and agreed that in the event of any occurrence which might give rise to a claim under this Clause, the Insured shall give a prompt notice to the Insurer prior to sending supervisors or engineers or prior to forwarding to the Insured's factory or other places.
